Cofton Hall

Cofton Hall is our brand-new halls of residence, providing deluxe en-suite accommodation.

In your bedroom, you'll have has a small double bed, integrated wardrobe, plus a desk for you to get on with your studies. You'll also have your own en-suite facilities with toilet, washbasin and shower.

Shared flats have an open-plan living / kitchen space - a great place to socialise with your flatmates. There's a sofa, dining table and a TV screen that you can use for your DVDs, games consoles or laptops.

Your kitchen is kitted out with all the appliances you need, like a cooker, toaster, kettle and microwave. Cofton Hall also has its own laundrette.




How to Apply

- · You'll need to complete an application form and return this by post.
- Forms are available in April / May at newman.ac.uk/accommodation.
 If you've made Newman your firm choice, you'll receive an email once the forms are available.
- · You should indicate on the form your preferences and any access requirements.
- You'll be advised that your application has been received and a room provisionally reserved, pending your place on the course being achieved.
- You'll receive a letter from us confirming your room type.
- You'll need to pay your deposit once you have received an accommodation confirmation. In 2018 this is £250.
- Make sure you set up your device to receive emails from Newman University, so you don't miss any vital information.
